# Treasurer's Report Annual Meeting - July 2021

I am happy to report that in spite of the pandemic and the hardship states are faced with, support for ACI and its work remains strong. Our financial condition is good and we are happy to be able to present this year's conference virtually at no cost to participants. We start the new fiscal year with a balance of \$86,144.53 in our checking account and a \$25,000 CD on deposit. At this time no increase in dues or award fees is anticipated and 2022 membership and awards program invoices will be emailed the week following the conference.

Round-up of FY 2021:

Prepared and sent out 1099s to ACI's two contractors.

- Filed required annual reports in Wyoming where ACI was incorporated (in 1984) and in the State of Vermont where we are now doing business.
- Transferred the balance from ACI's remaining NH checking account to our current Vermont account.
- Filed ACI annual IRS e-postcard form for nonprofit organizations. (501(c)3)
- Assisted host state of New Mexico purchase the Whova app we are using to bring this
  conference to life for conservation professionals around the U.S..
- Searching for a new CPA to review our accounts as our previous accountant has retired.
- Prepared a draft budget for discussion and approval at the 2021 annual meeting. (attached)
